<u>Public Comments/Correspondence:</u> Superintendent Todd Dugan received a letter/card from Representative Tim Butler congratulating the NH-M Staff/Faculty for volunteering at the Springfield Food Pantry in June. #### Discussion Items:

- a. <u>GRP Mechanical Proposal (continued)</u>-GRP Representatives Laura Weber and Matt Keller attended this meeting to discuss the previous issues for Health/Life Safety Amendment #17 from the May 20, 2015 Board of Education meeting. This discussion included the change order for the Air Handling Unit and Penthouse Roof Replacement as well as the Exterior Block Wall Replacement in the Science Classroom. BOE requested a breakdown for each proposal/change order. Items also included in this discussion were; funds for payments, grants, amount of time to complete work, billing, etc...
- b. <u>Transportation Fund Balance</u> –Upon looking at the Treasurer's Report Dated July 2015, NHM was waiting to receive voucher's processed by the State Comptroller for payment since transportation funds have been very tight this year. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of July, State Comptroller had issued 2 transportation vouchers bringing the transportation fund balance to a positive amount.
- c. <u>Master Schedule 2015-2016</u>-Superintendent Todd Dugan presented the new master schedule for the 2015-16 school year.
- d. <u>K-5 Reading Curriculum/Textbook Adoption:</u> Superintendent Todd Dugan updated the BOE on textbook options. Possibly entire District will be Title 1? Mr. Dugan is still researching this information.
